DIA (District Interim Assessments) have begun in reading and math for 3rd through 5th graders. These tests are covering standards our students have learned so far and are a tool for teachers to help them decide which concepts students master, and which may need to be taught at a deeper level. The reading and math tests will conclude on November 13th. The DIA in writing for grades 3-5 will be administered from Nov. 30th to Dec. 18th.

The DIAs are also a preparation for this year's SBAC, the new state wide test given in the spring. Parents can help their students by encouraging their children to improve their typing skills which are taught during library/ media time.

Ways to Help Children Become Better Readers

Here are six ways to support your child's reading at home. There are hundreds of studies that show the benefit of promoting reading in the home environment. Get creative and have fun. Read to your kids.

Try to find the time to read to your child as much as possible. A great time to read to your child is at bedtime.

Have them tell you their version of the "story."

After your child has finished a story, get creative. Have them change the story as they retell it into the story they would have written.

Listen to your child read.

When your child brings books home, have them read to you. Talk about if something doesn't make sense to go back and reread the sentence or passage again. When we go back and reread for clarity, research says that it can actually make all of us better readers.

Promote writing.

Write notes back and forth to each other.

Ask questions about what they are reading.

When your child reads ask them about characters, plot, and setting. If it's informational text (nonfiction) have them explain what the different parts are about and how it worked.

Make reading a regular activity in your home.

If everyone is doing it at home, kids will learn to love it. Adults can help their child so much by modeling the behavior of reading. Pick up a book and start today!
